

Adding XMP / XML Lightroom presets to Lightroom on desktop

Option A — Import .XMP files from inside Lightroom

1. Open **Lightroom**
 2. Go to the **Develop** module
 3. In the **Presets** panel click the “+” (**plus**) icon and choose **Import Presets....**
 4. Navigate to the folder containing your **.xmp** files, select one or many, and click **Import**.
 5. Presets appear in the Presets panel (they may be added under a new group/folder).
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Option B — Add XMP files manually to the presets folder

1. In Lightroom Classic, open **Edit > Preferences** (Windows) or **Lightroom Classic > Preferences**.
2. Click the **Presets** tab and click **Show Lightroom Develop Presets Folder** (or **Show All Other Lightroom Presets** on some versions).
 - This opens the folder that Lightroom uses for presets.
3. In the opened folder, open the **Develop Presets** (or **Settings**) subfolder.
4. Copy your **.xmp** files into that folder (or into a subfolder you create to organize presets).
5. Restart Lightroom Classic.
6. Presets show up in the Presets panel.

How to Add DNG Preset Files to Lightroom Mobile

1. Save the DNG preset files to your phone.
2. Launch the **Adobe Lightroom** app on your phone.
3. Go to the **Library** or **All Photos** view.
4. Tap the **Add Photos** button.
5. Select all the **DNG** files you downloaded and tap **Add**
6. Tap any one of the imported DNG photos.
7. With the DNG file open, tap the **⋮ (menu)** or **three dots** in the upper right.
8. Choose **Create Preset** and tap **Save**
